- * Novice Criteria for 2023- Per the ARYW By-laws the Novice Division State Tournament will be open to wrestlers in their first (Ist) or second (2nd) year of wrestling only. Verification of Novice status will be conducted prior to tournament start.
- * Open tournament will be open to Novice and Girls wrestlers at the completion of their tournaments.
- *A bracket committee of club coaches and ARYW board members will be formed prior to the tournament start to ensure that we have competitive and smart brackets TRUE SECOND WILL BE WRESTLED
- * Seating will be assigned by Club at the event. Your club will be notified prior to opening ceremonies as well as your section being labeled.
- * Late Registration closes on Tuesday February 7th, 2023 and will be \$50 All entries will have a shirt with their names on it for purchase with our official apparel sponsor.
- * All wrestlers will have to make SCRATCH-WEIGHT and complete a skin check prior to competition. A medical professional will be on hand to review any doctor notes and skin forms. Contact the tournament director if you have questions.
- * We will open the Novice and Girls with the National Anthem and recognitions. The Open tournament opening ceremonies will commence at 12:40p.m. with a procession of clubs. National Anthem and Special Announcements. Upon completion of the Open tournament to the medal rounds, we will break and then have a Parade of Champions and start medal rounds.
- * Pictures will be available by professional Marvin Winston Photography. Parents will be able to take podium pictures of their athletes
- * Hospitality room will be provided for Coaches and Referees DNLY.
- * Team points will be cumulative from all three divisions. We will award Top 3 teams in Small Club (39 and below) and Large Club (40+) and one "rookie" club. The rookie team champion will be the highest placing club in it's first or second year of chartering
- * This is a USAW Sanctioned Event Only athletes and Coaches with the proper credentials will be allowed on the event floor. ALL ATHLETES MUST BE USAW MEMBERS AND ASSIGNED TO A CHARTED AR CLUB TO PARTCIPATE IN EVENT.
